

Open Division Registration and Tournament Information

Entry Fee

Entry fee is \$400 per team. The registration deadline is Wednesday, January 1st. You will pay a \$50 deposit at the time of registration. Your card will be charged the additional \$350 if your team registers for the tournament and does not show up to play. Teams have until Wednesday, January 1st at 5:00 PM CST to notify us if your team cannot play in the tournament. The card on file will be charged the remainder of the entry fee if you do not notify us before January 3rd or if payment is not received before your first game.

**Only the first 24 teams are guaranteed entry into the Open Tournament! **

Open Team Registration

Games for the open division will take place January 4th and 5th. The entry fee is \$400 per team. This year there will be a First Place Cash Prize!! If your team is interested in participating, please email Clint Jones for further information and instructions.

Schedules

We will send the pool play out to all captain's on Friday January 3rd. Please note that all Open teams will play their first game on Saturday morning, January 4th as early as 8am.

Waivers

Every member of your team will need to sign the participant release form. This wavier can be brought to the tournament however, ever participant will need to have the wavier on file before they can play.

Eligibility

All other participants are invited to participate in the Open Division. This includes teams with faculty and/or staff members or military applications. Dates of play will be Saturday, January 4th through Sunday, January 5th.

Rules

Games will be played under NIRSA rules via the Flag Football Rulebook. This will be a 3 or 4 team pool play tournament with the top two teams out of each pool advancing to a single elimination playoff. We will be guaranteeing a 2-game minimum to all teams. Men's/Women's rosters are limited to 15 players and co-rec rosters are limited to 16 players. Collegiate rosters must be received no later than Friday, December 13th at 5:00 PM CST.
