## SPECIAL OLYMPICS UNIFIED CHAMPION SCHOOLS® SPOTLIGHT

### FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY

The Special Olympics at FSU club was started in the fall of 2019 by a group of undergraduate and graduate students that were all Unified partners in the local county sports. These partners had such a great experience being a part of Special Olympics Unified Soccer and Basketball teams that they wanted to make sure more students on campus had the opportunity to get involved. With support from SOFL, the newly formed club collaborated with SOFL-Leon County, FSU Campus Recreation, and FSU Sport Management to expand Unified Sports opportunities on campus by creating the university's first ever Unified team to play in the campus intramural flag football league. This team was followed by the first Unified sand volleuball and Unified kickball teams. As Unified Sports continued to gain momentum on campus, SO@FSU and FSU Campus Rec planned for a full Unified Basketball League in Spring 2020. Since then, Unified teams have participated in intramural wiffle ball and intramural soccer as well as hosted two FSUnified Day tournaments that were open to the Tallahassee community. With college students coming and going, sustainability of programming was always a consideration of SO@FSU programming. This is why involvement of Tallahassee residents continues to be a focus of SO@FSU activities. By offering a variety of opportunities for involvement, Unified Sports became a way to not only connect FSU students with Special Olympics athletes, but also to connect the campus and the community.
