"Following a highly successful pilot program in Spring Semester 2015, Michigan State's Department of Recreational Sports and Fitness Services (RSFS), Special Olympic Michigan (SOMI), and Special Olympics MSU (SOMSU, a registered student organization) increased the number of Unified Sports offerings on campus. The activities take place during the academic year, in conjunction with the IM Sports program. The increase in Unified Sports has helped strengthen the campus environment and has benefitted community members through engagement and inclusion in the program; over 1500 students/partners and athletes have participated in the program since its inception.




UNIFIED SPORTS EXPERIENCE: HOOP SHOOT CONTEST AT NIRSA ANNUAL CONFERENCE
